Note: Other music ensembles may be substituted for the required ensembles above with the permission of the Music faculty. Music

majors are also expected to attend at least three Music Program concerts each semester as audience members.

Students are required to enroll in studio instruction on the primary instrument during each semester of residence as a Music major, up to eight semesters. Students enrolled in culminating activities that do not involve music performance are exempt from the studio instruction requirement during the culminating activity year. Note: All students enrolled in studio instruction must be concurrently enrolled in the appropriate major ensemble.

Voice students take all four instrumental pedagogy courses only. Instrumentalists take those instrumental courses outside their specialty, plus the two voice classes.

For the Music Education Emphasis, MUS 1049 Music from a Global Perspective must be used for Area C1.

The SELF requirement may double count with C or D. Students are waived from UD area of their program. JYDR double counts with GWAR by taking ENGL 3119 Advanced Writing Advanced Writing. Capstone is satisfied within the major (senior seminar).
